The successful candidate will work on our productions at Nemeton and on live broadcasts/streams as part of the team which delivers live content and resolves issues with broadcast/multimedia systems.

The duties of this position include, but are not limited to, the below:

- General IT tasks and troubleshooting (emails: setup and backup/removal, printer issues)
- Desktop/Laptop Software updates and hardware upgrades
- Tech Supervision of Studio productions
- Downlinking and recording satellite feeds and streams
- Provide technical support on-site during production operations
- Prepare and supply broadcasters with programme record feeds from OB's following matches.
- Edit Suite Maintenance (Audio, Video, Software, Hardware)
- Basic Network admin (patching ethernet ports etc)
- Regular backup checks on all Laptops/Desktops
- Media Asset management
- Satellite Dish maintenance (cleaning, testing, repairs etc)
- Master Control Operations (MCR: Sat/Fibre/IP Uplink/Downlink)
- Web Streaming and OB Tech Operations (On site/at base)
